





The Association of Driving Schools of the Czech Republic has elected a new BOARD for 2021-2026

On January 28, 2021, the General Meeting of the Association of Driving Schools of the Czech Republic was held via an online video conference. The Association of Driving Schools is the largest association representing driving schools in the Czech Republic and to date has over 170 active members who carry out more than 40,000 driving licenses a year. The General Meeting elected the new management of the Association for the next 5 years.

At the meeting, a report on management and a report on activities evaluating the operations of the Association for the past year were presented. Furthermore, members of the Executive Board, the highest body of the Association, were elected. Aleš Horčička was elected Chairman of the Association of Driving Schools of the Czech Republic, Ondřej Horázný and Jiří Novotný were elected Vice-Chairmen.

Due to the volume of our activities, the General Meeting participants approved the extension of the Executive Board from nine to eleven members, and our new team is now even better prepared to defend the interests of driving school operators in the Czech Republic, " said Aleš Horčička. The Executive Board thanked the long-term Chairman Ondřej Horázný for his work for the Association of Driving Schools and they trust they will use his legislative and legal abilities in the next term as Vice-Chairman for the legislative activity of the Association of Driving Schools.

The Executive Board thanked the resigning member Bohumír Nejedlý for his contribution to the organization of the General Meetings in Česká Třebová and for further merits in the professionalisation of the activities of the Association of Driving Schools and its secretariat.

The General Meeting instructed the Executive Board to continue negotiations with the Ministry of Transport of the Czech Republic on legislative issues, especially in the matter of amending Act No. 247/2000 Coll. and in efforts to introduce a second phase of driver education.

The Association of Driving Schools of the Czech Republic will continue to actively participate in the meetings of the European Federation of Driving Schools and prepare seminars for teacher education. The enforcement of minimum standards for the operation of a driving school remains in mind for the next term.
