

On Friday 17 February, more than 450 delegates gathered in Brussels for the First Annual Forum of the Oceans Mission. The EU's 'Missions' are a new way of working bringing concrete solutions to some of our biggest challenges. They have ambitious objectives and, having to produce tangible results by 2030, give research and innovation a new role: deploying available solutions on the territories through a coordinated effort that pools the resources of the different funding programs.

Why a Mission Ocean and Waters?

Life on Earth depends on the health of the ocean-sea and-inland water system, which covers about 75% of its surface, regulates the climate and provides oxygen, clean water, clean energy and food. A system today at serious risk: restoring its health and its ability to provide wealth and resources requires joint and targeted actions.
