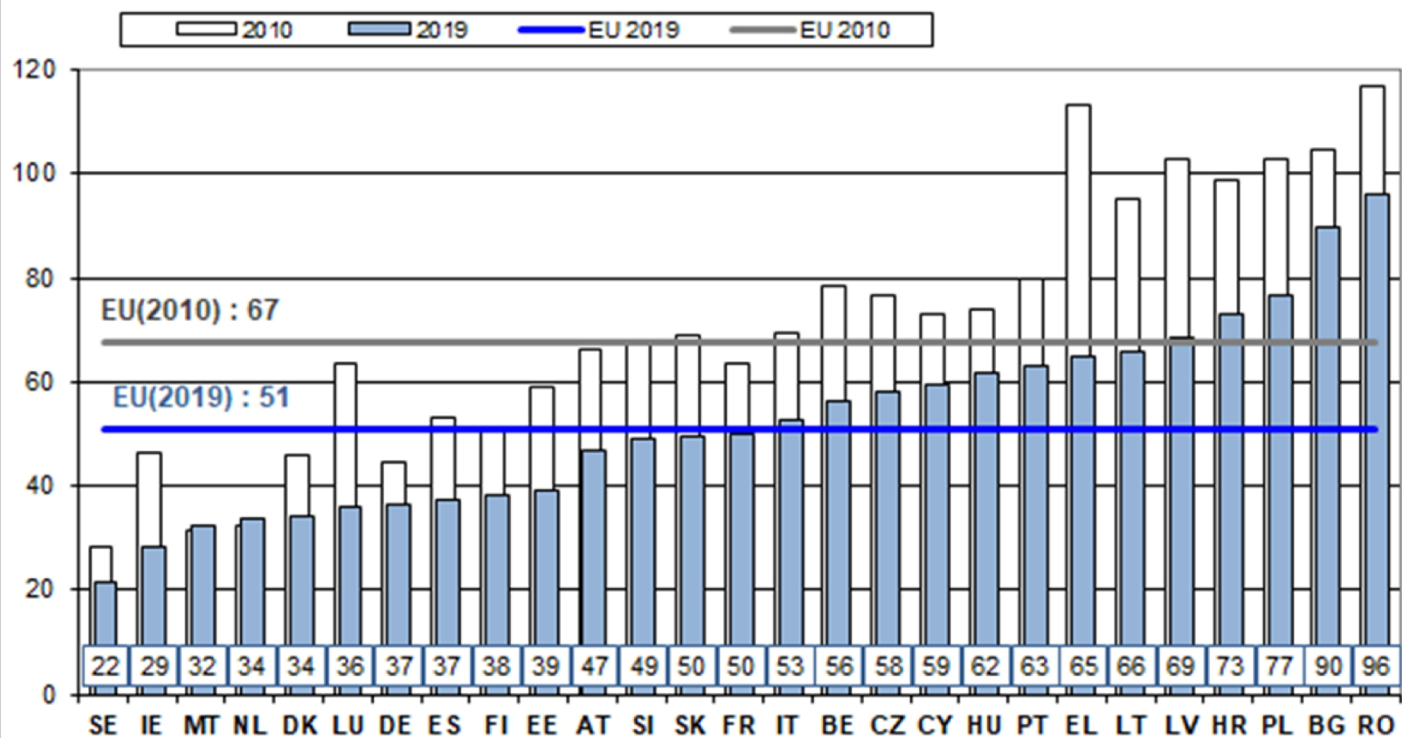

The extent of the road safety problem

- 1 million crashes per year
- 23 000 deaths in 2019
- 120 000 serious injuries
- Downward trend ... but flatlining since 2013
- Convergence between Member States ... but large gap exists

Road fatalities per million population, 2010-2019



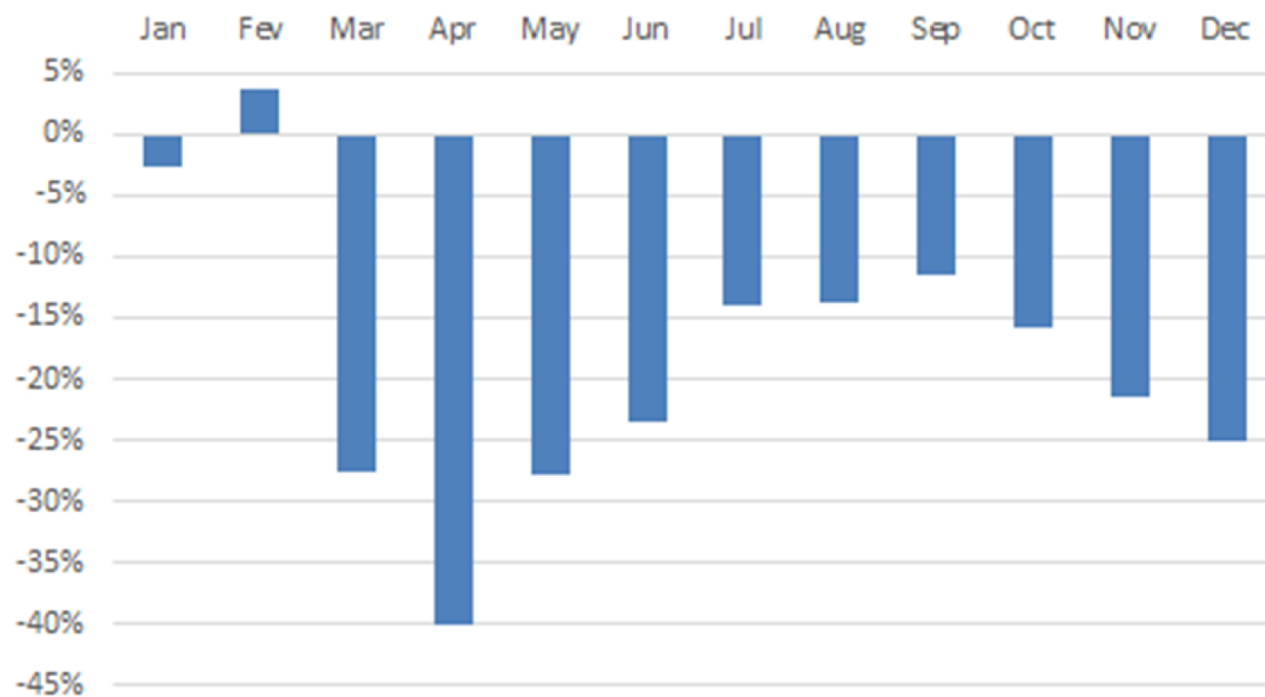
