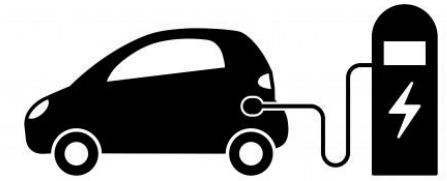

ELECTRIC CARS IN DRIVING SCHOOLS CONTRIBUTE TO CLIMATE PROTECTION



- Eco-driving and saving fuel is an important goal of driving licence training in Austria.
- After obtaining a driving licence, young drivers have to complete another on-road skill refinement session at their driving school within one year. They learn eco-driving techniques and how to save up to 14 percent in fuel consumption.
- In the future, learner drivers should become familiar with electric cars in their driving school at an earlier stage.
- For easier obtainment of an unrestricted driving licence, a few practical driving lessons on a vehicle with a manual gearbox and a small skills test (by the driving instructor), rather than a full test (by official examiners), should suffice to obtain an unrestricted driving licence and to cancel Code 78.

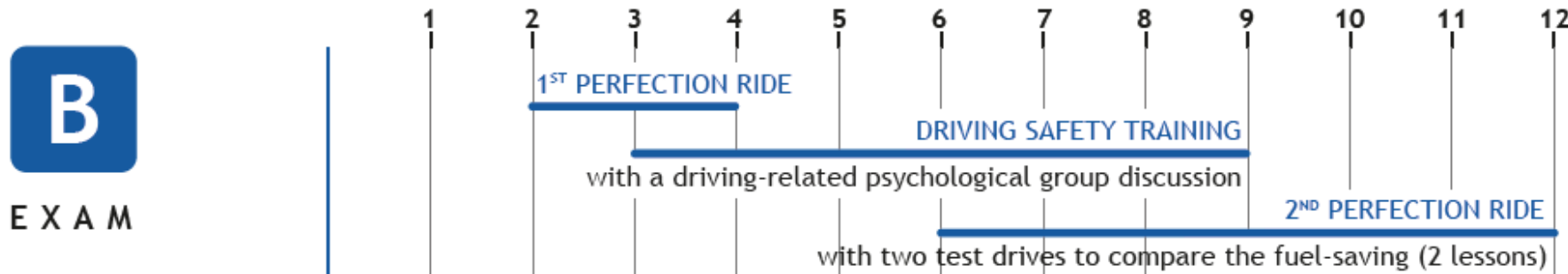

Multi-phase training with perfection ride and driving safety training

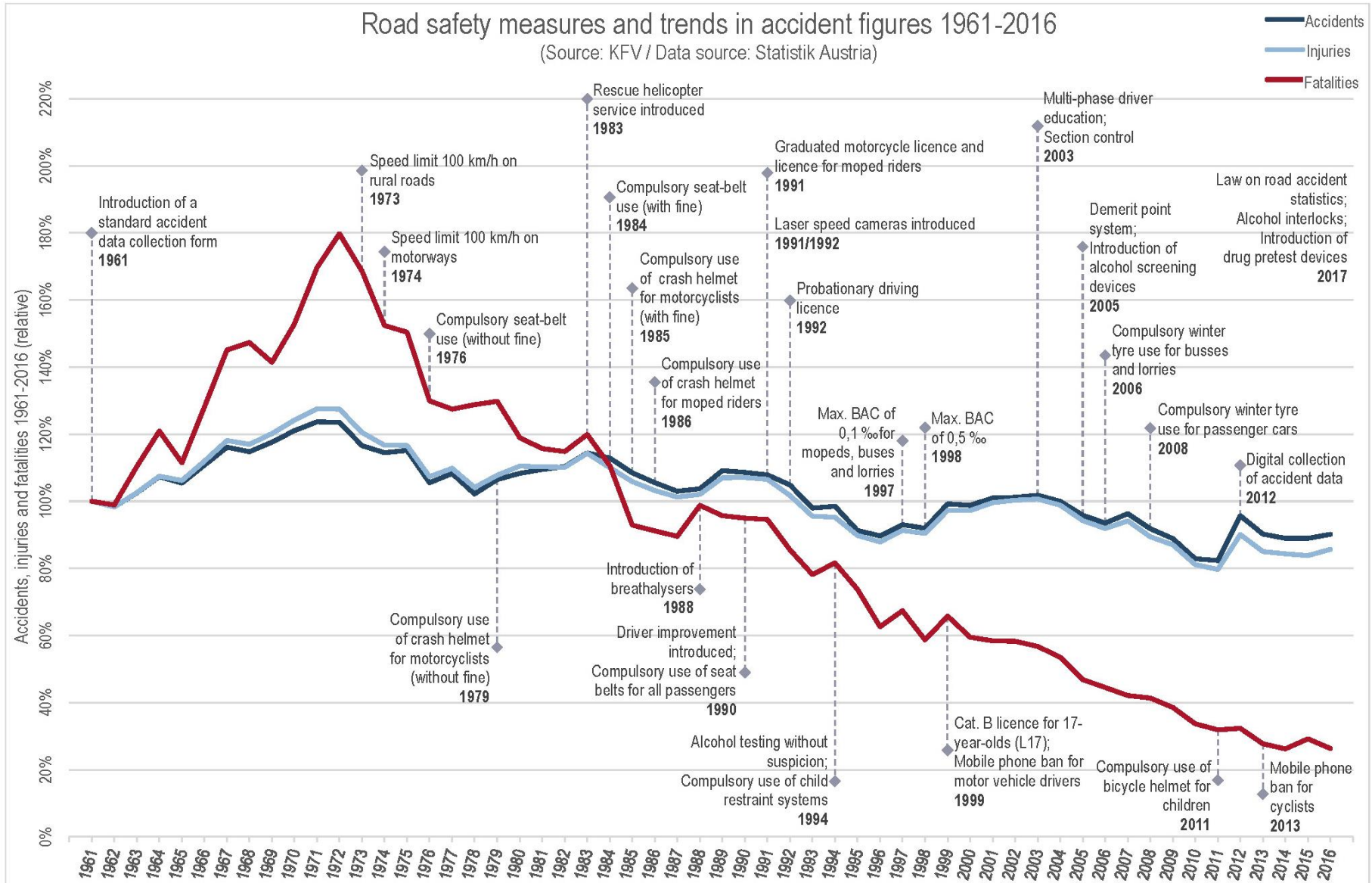


Second on-road skill refinement session with focus on environmentally conscious and fuel-efficient driving style

1. During a drive of at least 15 minutes, fuel consumption and trip duration are measured.
2. In-depth discussion of the key principles of environmentally conscious and fuel-efficient driving.
3. Repetition of the drive, during which fuel consumption and trip duration are measured again.
4. Comparison of the two trips.
5. Analysis of the results of the two drives in terms of environmentally conscious driving and road safety.
6. The two drives have to be completed by all new drivers.

Road safety measures and trends in accident figures 1961-2016

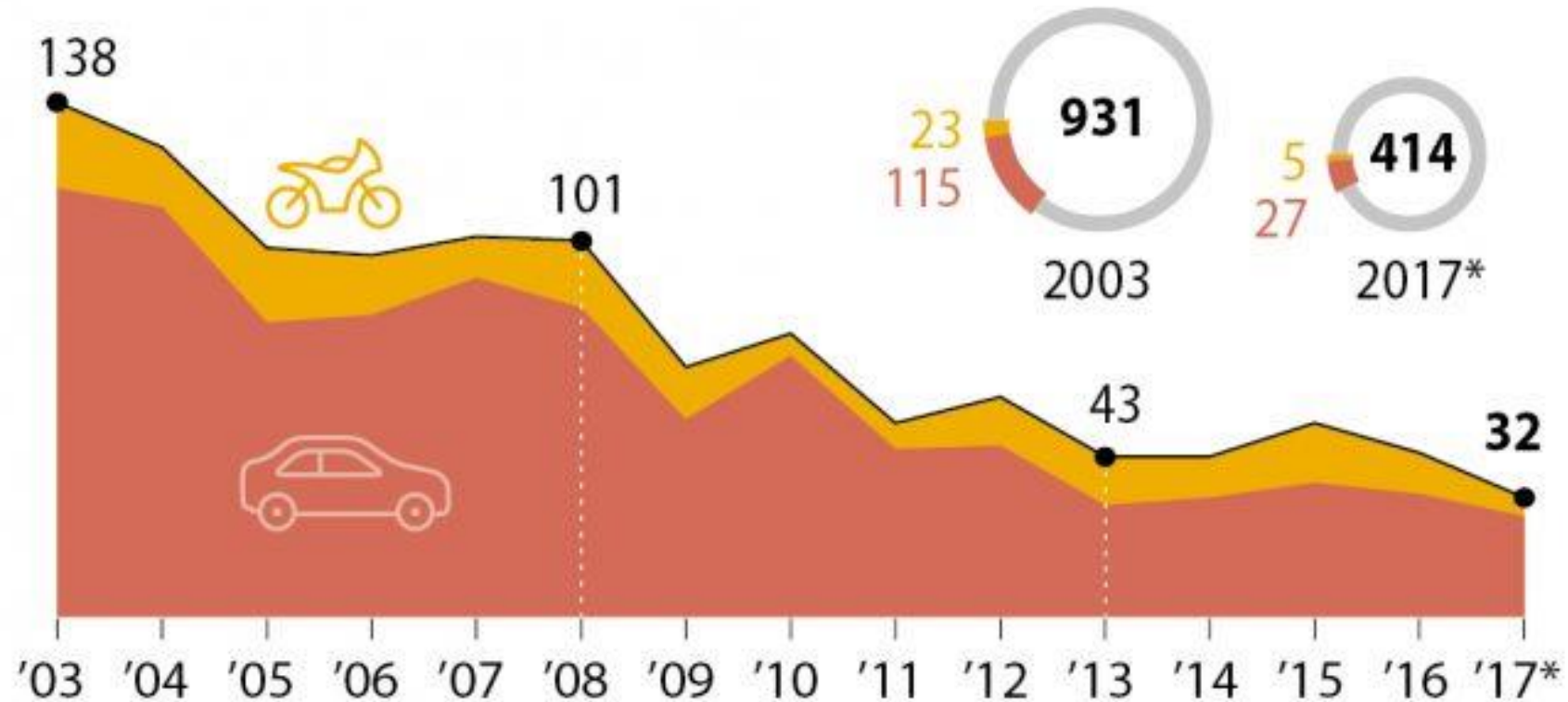

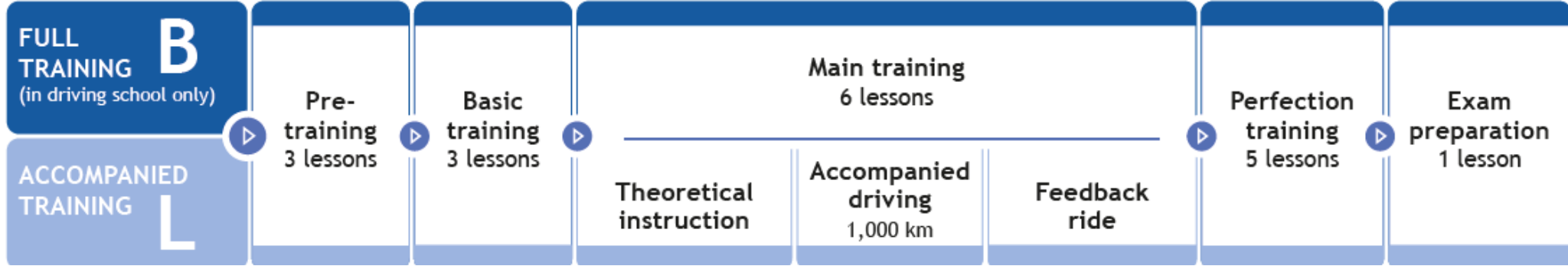

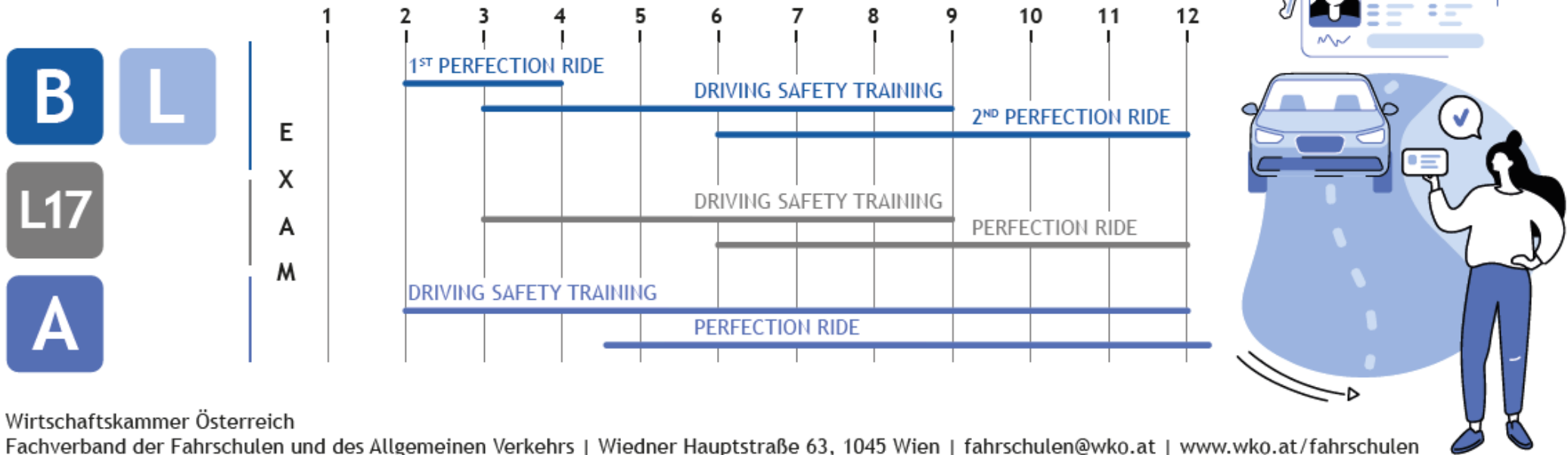

Multi-phase training with perfection ride and driving safety training

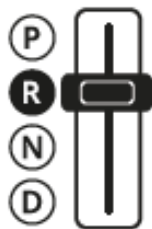

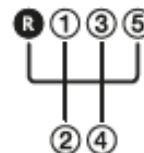

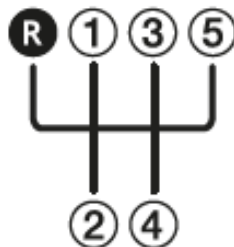
